

Safely Welcoming Students to Campus

Tier 2 Highlights

A Tier 2 will be used when additional precaution is necessary due to national, state, or local health orders, guidance, or conditions OR when school facilities or personnel constraints do not allow for Tier 1 instruction to safely occur. Tier 2 is a hybrid learning environment in which students are scheduled to attend school in smaller cohorts to further mitigate the possibility of spread and minimize potential school closures. In Tier 2 hybrid learning, students would attend school two to three days a week and remain home two to three days a week. *The determination to transition to Tier 2 will be evaluated and adjusted based on local developments and updated guidelines.*

- All prevention and protection measures (masks, social distancing, visual cues, etc.) outlined in the Tier 1 overview will be in effect for students and teachers when they are on campus for Tier 2. Please review those measures in the Tier 1 document.
- Teachers will be teaching the scheduled on-campus groups five days a week.
- Students will be grouped by families into an *A* group and a *B* group. All children within a single family will attend school on the same days.

• Both groups will come to campus two days a week and alternate attending on Fridays.

- When students are on campus, they will receive direct instruction in the classroom. Students will be given independent assignments and activities to complete at home the next day.
- When students are at home, they will complete independent assignments and activities. Submission and evaluation may be at the next in-person meeting or through technology. On days when students are at home, they may need guidance from an adult to ensure completion of assignments.
- Elementary students and teachers will use Google Classroom to manage educational content from school to home.
- Time allocated to Elementary music, art, library, and computer classes will be adjusted.
- Middle and high school students and teachers will use the FACTS Learning Management System to manage educational content from school to home.
- Middle and high school class schedules may be altered during Tier 2 to increase class time in core subjects when on campus, especially in a prolonged Tier 2 operation. Under an altered schedule, high school students will still earn the required credits for graduation.
- Protocol for positive cases and exposure is the same as explained on the Tier 1 overview document.
